Application Details of Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy Awards 2026

I. Selection Time

The selection starts from today onward to 24:00 on September 30, 2026 (Beijing Time). Registration applications will no longer be accepted after the deadline.

II. Selection Object

1. IoT and intelligently interconnected digital economy government agencies and research institutions;
2. IoT and intelligently interconnected digital economy enterprises and entrepreneurs;
3. IoT and intelligently interconnected digital economy scientific and technological outcomes, software and hardware products, application service platforms;
4. IoT and intelligently interconnected digital economy standard organizations, IoT business associations and chambers of commerce;
5. Experts, scholars and management talents engaged in IoT digital economy development and theoretical foundation study;
6. Individuals and institutions making major contributions to the global intelligently interconnected digital economy.

III. Selection Scope

Companies, as well as solutions, software and hardware products and technologies in IoT or intelligently interconnected digital economy-based industry (including intelligent manufacturing), healthcare, agriculture, energy, logistics, cultural tourism, smart cities (communities), public governance affairs, artificial intelligence, aerospace, military and civilian technology, ecological and environmental protection, transportation and auto intelligence, finance, security and safety, smart life (including wearable devices, and smart homes), modern services and other fields.

IV. Selection Approach

The application is made by individuals, enterprises or institutions themselves, or through recommendations from national and local governments, institutions, chambers of commerce or associations, and recommendations from organizations of the World Internet of Things Convention.

V. Type of Awards



The Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy Awards is divided into categories of “enterprise” (Leading Enterprise Award, Outstanding Enterprise Award, and Excellent Enterprise Award), “person” (Special Contribution Award, Promotion Award, Leader of the Year Award, and Outstanding Person of the Year Award) and “project” (including but not limited to technology, product, development and application, service, industry promotion, etc.).

VI. Application Approach

1. If the application is from institutions/ enterprises/ individuals, please fill in the “Application Form for Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy Awards 2025”, sign and seal (for international companies, the person in charge shall sign and confirm), and send the completed application form and the scanned electronic copy to the email awards@wiotc.org;
2. The applying institutions, enterprises or individuals must provide introduction materials of IoT products, solutions, or application services (including but not limited to image materials, papers, physical products or items, solution materials, technologies and outcomes, successful experience or suggestions, speech display or annual output value of application services, etc.), intellectual property information, qualification and honor information, and related supporting materials.

VII. Selection Process

Registration for application → eligibility review (nomination period) → preliminary evaluation → announcement → final evaluation → awarding

VIII. Announcement

All award-winning organizations and individuals will be announced on the official website of WIOTC (www.wiotc.org) for public comment before they are finally commended and presented with trophies and certificates.

IX. Time of Awarding

The awarding ceremony for all awards will be held at the Second Conference on Sustainable Development of Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy and WIOTC 2026.

X. Preferential Treatment for Winners

1. Information of award-winning companies, institutions and projects will be announced on the official website of WIOTC and its WeChat public platform;
2. Award-winning institutions and individuals will be entitled to publicize their companies, products, technologies or solutions on the WIOTC official website;
3. Award-winning institutions and individuals can apply for priority to make



- presentations or participate in high-end dialogues at the World Internet of Things Convention (annual conference) to promote their projects/ products;
4. Award-winning companies, institutions and individuals can have the priority to obtain the member qualification of joining related digital economy industrial committees;
 5. Award-winning companies, institutions and individuals will have the opportunity to be part of the WIOTC digital economy projects promotion, and enjoy the priority of cooperation with conference events, platforms, and projects;
 6. Award-winning companies, institutions and individuals can enjoy the membership of the Internet of Things Innovation Alliance for free.

XI. Notes

1. The companies/institutions and individuals participating in the selection must submit the real selection materials, technologies, patents, and solutions, and shall be liable for the authenticity of the submitted materials and relevant laws and regulations;
2. The Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy Awards Organizing Committee will conduct a qualification review of all companies, products, projects, technical outcomes, programs, academic articles, etc. that declare the awards based on the application materials; the candidates will be selected from the institutions or individuals that have passed the qualification review and will be based on application materials;
3. The companies, projects, products, development and innovation outcomes, solutions involved in the selection that need on-site inspection of experts can apply to the organizing committee, and shall bear the costs of the selection of experts and other related expenses;
4. The registered products, technologies, solutions and scientific and technological outcomes must comply with relevant laws and regulations and existing standards;
5. The registered products, technologies, solutions and scientific and technological outcomes should have no intellectual property disputes and no infringement of rights;
6. The applicant must organize the completion of the declaration form and submit the relevant declaration materials in accordance with the specific requirements of the "Registration and Application Form for 2026 Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy Awards";
7. If faking or infringing acts are found, the organizing committee will cancel the selection and award qualifications;
